## NUMBER AND TYPES OF ORGANISMS REQUESTED

As of January 1st, 2009

- All isolates of viridans streptococci from blood cultures
- First <u>20 consecutive</u> isolates of *Group A Strep from Throat, and all isolates* from sterile sites
- First <u>20 consecutive</u> clinically relevant isolates of **Streptococcus pneumoniae** (all sites, any susceptibility pattern)
   THEN:
- All STERILE SITE isolates of Streptococcus pneumoniae
- First 10 consecutive isolates of *Haemophilus influenzae*
- <u>5</u> isolates of *E. coli* resistant to 3<sup>rd</sup> generation cephalosporins (from any site)
- First 5 consecutive Moraxella catarrhalis isolates
- First 10 consecutive clinically relevant isolates of **Staphylococcus aureus**

## PROCEDURES TO FOLLOW

- 1. Identify isolates(s) for study effective January 1, 2008.
- 2. Freeze isolates until ready to ship in a batch (if possible, wait to ship when you have your first sets of consecutive isolates)
- 3. Fill in appropriate Specimen Log Sheet(s), supplied. NO OTHER PAPERWORK IS REQUIRED.
- 4. Ship via Federal Express or Purolator. Waybills, pre-addressed Saf-T-paks, supplied.
